



A BRIEF HISTORY

Above all, the Belleville Club is a social club. It was established on April 3, 1914. The first president was S.E. Carman, and the first honorary president was the Honourable Henry Corby. The building at the corner of Front and Pinnacle Streets has been home to the Belleville Club since its inception, the heart of "The Village" in Downtown Belleville.

For many years, bedrooms were available on the upper floors for permanent residents and out-of-town guests. Those rooms have been converted to conference rooms and games rooms.

In 1994, on New Year's Eve, a devastating fire swept through the Club. Fortunately, the main structure was saved. The restoration of the Club was completed the following year.

BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

The Belleville Club is a not-for-profit limited company, owned by its members and its shareholders. Members each receive a key, and have almost unlimited use of the Club, twenty-four hours a day. The Belleville Club still maintains its post-Victorian elegance. The ambience is enhanced by its high ceilings, expansive staircases, brilliant Persian carpets, hardwood floors, and rich oak-panelled walls in the Main Dining Room. The large room will accommodate 150 people, and the elegant small dining room is licenced for 35 people. There is a state-of-the-art sound system, and a wonderful new grand piano at the Club.
